

# FUERTE BULNES

## PUNTA ARENAS



Only 53km south of Punta Arenas city is located the Patagonia most historic place. The main attraction of the park is Fuerte Bulnes, which, from 1843 keeps an eye on the Strait. The shack, prison, the batteries from the south and the north, chapel, stables and other constructions in the fort cover the normal tour that takes an hour to go through. Close to the fort, we will enjoy the Estrecho viewpoint from which we will observe Magallanes Strait with the beautiful background. Do not miss the opportunity to go through the coastal road that, across a soft path surrounded by rocky cliffs, extends in the middle of nothofagus, berberis and dimiys forests. It gives us the best views on the islands and the

mountains that form Brunswick peninsula and Fueguino archipelago. In Refugio Del Fuerte, we will find a souvenir shop, handicraft, books and the possibility to enjoy a cup of coffee. Before going back to Punta Arenas, we will recommend you to visit Puerto Del Hambre sector, a place chosen by the Spanish conquistadors' fleet to build Rey Don Felipe city in 1584.
