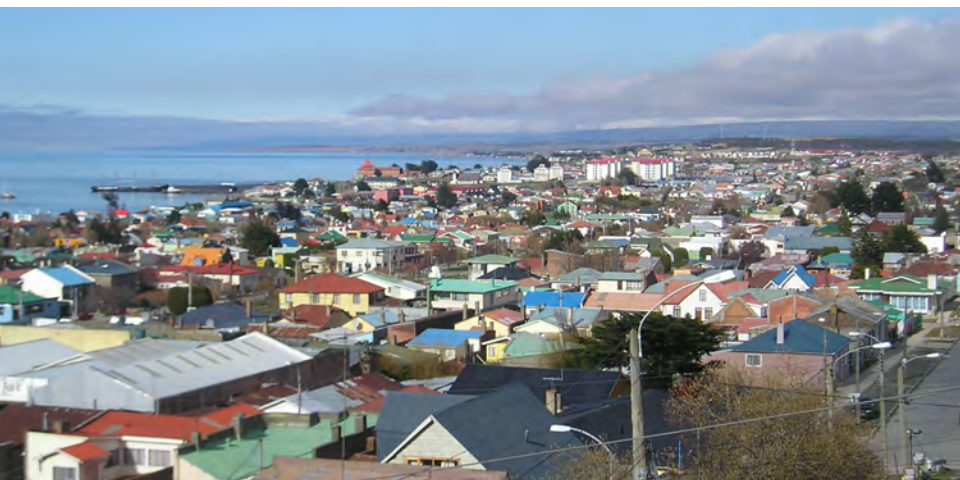


PUNTA ARENAS CITY TOUR



Visiting Punta Arenas, the most southern city of the whole American continent is a trip through Patagonia's history. The first stop will be "Cerro de la Luz" viewpoint from which you will have a beautiful panoramic view on the city and its colored roofs, the Magallanes Strait and the Tierra del Fuego great island in the background. During this stop, our local guide will give us some important information about the city. The trip will continue through Puerto Varas' impeccable streets and eventually reach Plaza de Armas, square surrounded by stunning colonial buildings. Moreover, you can observe the

Hernando de Magallanes monument and have the possibility to buy some local handicrafts. The last part of the tour includes a trip to the northern sector of the city that will allow us to appreciate a huge amount of monuments such as Ovejero monument, Croata square, Antoine de Saint Exupéry square and several districts of Punta Arenas until going back to the hotel.
