

# CULTURAL CITY TOUR



Tour riddled with history, ideal for the lovers of old millenary and modern cultures. We will visit the unique and distinctive Santiago historic center that mixes harmoniously monuments from different ages. During the tour, we will visit La Chascona that conserves among many collections, an interesting picture gallery with Chilean and foreign painters artworks of all times. There is also a collection of wooden African sculptures, and another one from Piero Fornasetti designer furniture and objects. There is certainly Neruda's atmospheres such as his dining room with the originals dishes and cutlery. Afterwards, we will visit

the Pre-Columbian Art Museum that has quite some similitudes with Palacio de la Moneda since its floors were designed by the same architect, the Italian Joaquin Toesca. It has a neoclassic style and has been declared national monument in 1960. The main interests remain in the objects and creations of many indigenous cultures from Northern Mexico until Southern Andes. Moreover, it has a specialized library in Pre-Columbian art and conservation.
