

# PUERTO MONTT CITY TOUR; NATURE AND HISTORY

We will start our trip going 9km west of Puerto Varas, in Nueva Braunau, village founded in 1875 by families coming from Bohemia Province of the then Austro-Hungarian Empire. They settled there to make a living from farming and livestock. Nowadays, this village is characterized by its dairies and its Antonio Felner Niklitschek museum that collects an important exhibition of objects representing colonization process in the area. A showing of the new gastronomic, architectural, artistic, musical and clothing traditions of the colonists. Through Las Lomas way, we will arrive at Lahuen Ñadi natural monument, a larch forest with specimens from 5 to 1800 years old and where some trees reach 40 meters high. We will go through an interpretative path where we will appreciate cinnamon tree, coigüe and several fern species. Regarding fauna, it

is possible to appreciate birds such as Carpintero Negro, the Huet Huet and the Chucaco, mammals such as Pudú, the Zorro Gris and the Monito del Monte. Afterwards, we will continue to Angelmó sector, famous in our country for its huge quantity of handicraft shops and of course the fishermen small cove and the local market where we will see the daily local activity of seamen who arrive at this place bringing fish and seafood to sell them at the market. We will find typical cuisines where is sold the most delicious and typical meals that characterize our region.
