### **Day 1 / Airport – Santiago – HD Santiago City Tour**

Arrival at Santiago. Reception at the Airport and transfer to the hotel In the afternoon we will start with a City Tour by Santiago. The capital of Chile is a vibrant city full of character, with a thriving artistic culture, modern restaurants and lively nightlife. Surrounded by mountains - the mighty Andes to the east and the smaller coastal range to the west - on a clear day, Santiago boasts one of the most incredible urban scenes in the world. Old-world colonial mansions and eclectic neighborhoods seamlessly integrate the skyscrapers of "Sanhattan" into a captivating fusion of tradition and modernity. With world-class skiing, wine routes, biking and trekking right at your doorstep, Santiago is a city full of stimulating possibilities.

Our tour starts from the hotel where the transfer will pick us up. We will start through the main avenue of the city, knowing its history and its surroundings. We will go down to the cobblestone neighborhood of Lastarría, a characteristic sector for its green areas and beautiful houses of the XIX century, now restored and mostly used as cafes, restaurants, bookstores and museums.

Then, we will go to Cerro Santa Lucia here we will have time to walk and take pictures, while our guide tells us some of the most important episodes in the history of Santiago, such as the Mapuche / Spanish confrontation. From its terraces we will have a panoramic view of Santiago, as well as admire relics and constructions from the colonial era, such as Castillo Hidalgo.

We will go to our next stop, on the way we can see emblematic places of the city such as the Plaza de Armas, The Santiago Cathedral and its impressive architecture, in addition to the former national congress. We will arrive at the imposing government house called "La Moneda" and next to it the "Plaza de la Constitución"; We will visit its surroundings and we will know more about its important and interesting history.

Once in our vehicle, the tour will continue with a step through the Central Market, one of the most characteristic gastronomic points of Santiago, and then continue to the upper sector of the capital. On the way we will stop at a lapis lazuli store where we can admire and/or buy beautiful jewelry and unique crafts. Then we will finish the tour at the respective hotel (accommodation included).

### **Day 2 / Santiago – FD Maipo Valley**

In the morning, we will visit one of the world's most famous vineyards, The Concha y Toro vineyard. We will walk in the surrounding area while tasting some of the best wines in this beautiful European style park. In the park, the manor house of Pirque stands out majestically, an architectural monument built in the late XIX century. Walking around the park and the Lagoon, we will see the vineyards that give origin to the production of the best Cabernet Sauvignon from Chile. One of the most significant vineyard's attractions is its ancient cellars where the founder Don Melchor Concha y Toro kept some of their best wines. In here, we will learn about the Casillero del Diablo legend, which made famous the Chilean wine in the world. Then we will go to the Santa Rita vineyard where we will learn about Chilean history and viticulture. We will start in the Vineyards; a garden of varieties allows us to learn more about different grapevine and their characteristics. We will know about the wine production process, through winemaking, fermentation cellars and the bottling plant. We will visit the Historic Cellar 1, built in "Cal y Canto"; also, we will visit the famous 120 Patriots Cellar, National Monument. We will finalize the tour with a tasting of two Reserve wines. Return to the Hotel (accommodation included).



### **Day 3 / Santiago – FD Colchagua Valley**

We will begin a magical journey to the Colchagua Valley. A trip of almost 2.5 hours to reach this beautiful valley, renowned for its beautiful, interesting landscapes and its historical importance about wine. Our first stop will be in Viña Montes where we will visit its cellars, and the wine shop & souvenirs. We will taste its famous wines and then we will have time to enjoy lunch (not included) in Santa Cruz city. Then we will visit Colchagua Museum, where an exhibition will provide us with a rich range of topics and will surprise us by its historical importance. Later, we will go to Viña Viu Manent, a place that we will visit by ancient horse-drawn carriages while our guide tell us about main characteristics of this place. Here, we will taste wine directly from the tank and we will visit the barrel room. Return to the selected hotel (accommodation included).

### **Day 4 / Santiago – FD Casablanca Valley**

We will start our tour from the hotel in Santiago, to the Chilean Coast wines valleys. During the journey, we will appreciate the diversity of Curacavi Valley landscapes, and we will continue to the Casablanca Valley, mostly known for the production of white wine. We will visit the Indomita vineyard (alternatively Veramonte vineyard). Tourists will be welcomed in the lobby and then we will go through the vineyard where we will learn about the vineyard management techniques used during the year, while enjoying one of the most beautiful panoramic views on the valley. We will walk around the stunning tank room and continue to the barrel room. We will have a technical wine tasting that will allow us enjoy the benefits of Casablanca Valley. Later, we will go to Casas del Bosque, where we will enjoy a video about Casablanca Valley and winemaking processes. Finally, we will have a guided tour and finalize the journey tasting two Reserve wines and one Great Reserve wine. Return to the Hotel (accommodation included).

### **Day 5 / Santiago – Out**

At the agreed time, transfer to the Airport to board flight to your country destination.
