Day 1 / Airport – Santiago – HD Santiago City Tour

Arrival in Santiago. Reception at the airport and transfer to the selected hotel. In the afternoon, we will make a City Tour of Santiago. The capital of Chile is a vibrant city full of character, with a thriving artistic culture, modern restaurants and lively nightlife. Surrounded by mountains - the mighty Andes to the east and the smaller coastal range to the west - on a clear day, Santiago boasts one of the most incredible urban scenes in the world. Old-world colonial mansions and eclectic neighborhoods seamlessly integrate the skyscrapers of "Sanhattan" into a captivating fusion of tradition and modernity. With world-class skiing, wine routes, biking and trekking right at your doorstep, Santiago is a city full of stimulating possibilities.

Our tour starts from the hotel where the transfer will pick us up. We will start through the main avenue of the city, knowing its history and its surroundings. We will go down to the cobblestone neighborhood of Lastarría, a characteristic sector for its green areas and beautiful houses of the XIX century, now restored and mostly used as cafes, restaurants, bookstores and museums.

Then, we will go to Cerro Santa Lucia here we will have time to walk and take pictures, while our guide tells us some of the most important episodes in the history of Santiago, such as the Mapuche / Spanish confrontation. From its terraces we will have a panoramic view of Santiago, as well as admire relics and constructions from the colonial era, such as Castillo Hidalgo.

We will go to our next stop, on the way we can see emblematic places of the city such as the Plaza de Armas, The Santiago Cathedral and its impressive architecture, in addition to the former national congress. We will arrive at the imposing government house called "La Moneda" and next to it the "Plaza de la Constitución"; We will visit its surroundings and we will know more about its important and interesting history.

Once in our vehicle, the tour will continue with a stop through the Central Market, one of the most characteristic gastronomic points of Santiago, and then continue to the upper sector of the capital. On the way we will stop at a lapis lazuli store where we can admire and/or buy beautiful jewelry and unique crafts (accommodation included).

Day 2 / Santiago – HD Traditional Concha y Toro

We will visit one of the most renowned vineyards worldwide, The Concha y Toro vineyard. We will walk around the enclosure while we will taste some of the best wines in this beautiful European style park where stands out majestically the manor house of Pirque, architectural monument built in the late XIX century. Walking around the park and the lagoon, we will see the vineyards that give origin to the production of the best Cabernet Sauvignon from Chile. One of the most significant attraction of the vineyard are its ancient cellars where the founder Don Melchor Concha y Toro kept some of their best wines. In here, we will learn about the Casillero Del Diablo legend, which made famous the Chilean wine in the world. Return to the selected hotel (accommodation included).

Day 3 / Santiago – FD Panoramic Valle Nevado

We will get to the highest point of the Andes Mountain and enjoy the amazing experience of skiing in Valle Nevado. We can easily enjoy the snow since this ski center has the most secure facilities, also counts on exclusive sectors, one for the beginners and other where we can practice our ski abilities.



Valle Nevado is the most known ski center in Chile and one of the most important of South America. Every year we are chosen by tourists from all over the world who want to simply enjoy the view or practice all the activities.

We start from the hotel early in the morning. Valle Nevado is located 65 km away of Santiago. On the way we can stop at a store to rent ski clothing if you need (on winter season) or trekking shoes (on summer season). This excursion is mostly for people who does not want to do ski activities necessarily and just want to enjoy a relax day (lunch, clothing and equipment rental and activities not included) (accommodation included).

Day 4 / Santiago – FD Three valleys panoramic

We start from the hotel at a previously appointment time to the Three Valleys, which is a set of high mountain villages that shares it's ski centers. The trip to the mountains last aproximately 2 hours. On the way we can stop at a store to rent ski clothing if you need (on winter season) or trekking shoes (on summer season).

Our first stop is La Parva ski center, located at 2.750 meters high and considered one of the most exclusive ski centers of the region. Here we will have some time to appreciate the place in order to continue with the trip.

Our second stop is El Colorado ski center. Here is where on 2010 took place the Freeskiing World Tour, with the chilean rider Cristóbal Chopo Díaz as the main guest. Nowadays, counts on 112 ski rinks and 1100 hectares of skiable Surface, reason which it's considere done of the best ski centers of South America.

Our last stop is Farellones Snow Park. This ski center is focused on those people who want to know the snow for the first time and enjoy an excellent service. The activities you can enjoy here are Tubing, Canopy or ski lift (Entrance fee to Farellones Park, lunch, ski clothes, ski equipment, ski lessons not included). Return to the selected hotel (accommodation included).

Day 5 / Santiago – Out

At the agreed time, transfer to the airport to board your flight.
