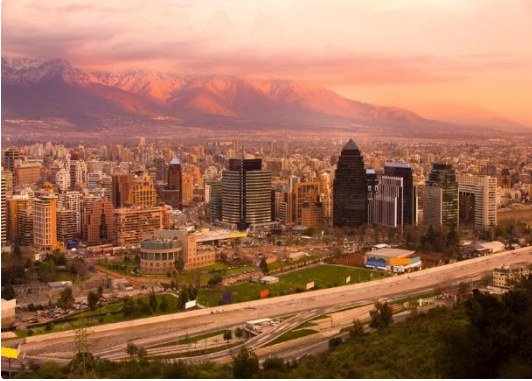

Day 1 / Santiago – Puerto Montt – Puerto Varas

Arrival in Puerto Montt. Reception at the Airport and transfer to the selected hotel (accommodation included).

Day 2 / Puerto Varas – HD Osorno Volcano

We will start our excursion from Puerto Varas, the “Roses City”, to Osorno volcano, bordering Llanquihue lake. We will enjoy a beautiful view on the snowy Osorno and Cabulco volcanoes until we arrive at Ensenada where we will start our ascent. We will reach the Osorno Volcano ski resort, located 1.240 m above the sea level. We will be up there for an hour and we will have the time to enjoy the landscape, take pictures and appreciate a unique view on volcanoes’ summits and its eternal snow glaciers, on Cabulco, Llanquihue Lake and the Pacific Ocean. Passengers will have the option to have a cup of coffee or hot chocolate, or taking the chairlift to reach from 1.450m high on the Primavera resort to 1.750m high in the Glacier resort. From there, we will enjoy a stunning and impressive view on Llanquihue Lake. Return to the selected hotel where we will have lunch (not included).

Day 3 / FD Chiloé, Castro and Dalcahue

We will start our excursion on the way to Pargua, place from which we will board a ferry to navigate through Chacao channel that separates the continent from Chiloe Great Island. During the sailing, we can observe sea lions, pelicans and marine bird life typical from this region. We will dock at Chacao village where you will see traditional buildings made from larch tree wood as well as a church declared national monument. Then, we will continue our trip to Dalcahue, city located in front of Quinchao Island that has on its waterfront a Palafitos traditional market with a spectacular view. Moreover, we will visit its church, a typical Chiloean monument which is a UNESCO heritage site. Afterwards, we will continue our trip to Castro city, Chiloe Island capital city and will enjoy the lovely view on its famous Palafitos from Gamboa viewpoint, we will visit San Francisco Church in front of the city square and we will pass by Chiloe biggest artisanal market. On our way back we will visit Ancud city where we will visit San Antonio fortress, a historic place which is a part of the last Spanish fortifications in our country, the local museum, Plaza de Armas and the local market that offers several gastronomic options from the island. At the lunch place (not included) we will coordinate with the guide depending on the logistics and the schedules of the excursion. Return to the hotel in Puerto Varas.

Day 4 / FD Peulla

We will sail through the marvelous Todos los Santos Lake, we will visit the internationally famous Petrohué river waterfalls as well as Peulla, a small ecological village with 120 inhabitants, which is part of the renowned “Cruce Andino” touristic tour. Once visited the Petrohué falls, we will sail for almost two hours on Todos los Santos lake, observing Osorno, Puntagudo and Tronador volcanoes. In this place, we will have time to enjoy lunch (included). We will have the opportunity to make some adventure tourism excursions such as canopy, horse-riding, fishing trip, jet-boat trip, 4x4 Safari that this natural paradise offers. Return to the selected hotel (accommodation included).



Day 5 / Puerto Varas – Out

At the agreed time, transfer to the Puerto Montt Airport.
